SHMURA MATZA ORDER FORM

The term "shmurah" is used in referring to a special type of matza used to fulfill the mitzva of eating matza. What places the matza in the category of shmurah?

Exodus 12:17 "You shall observe (guard) the unleavened bread." The concept of guarding (shmira) has two aspects: 1) not allowing the cut wheat and flour to become chometz, and 2) the process is dedicated for the mitzva of matza. If either of these two conditions are lacking, then it can not be considered "Shmura Matza".

It is preferable to use Shmura Matza for the mitzvah of matza at the Seder, and there are those who try to eat only Shmura Matza throughout the eight days of Pesach.
